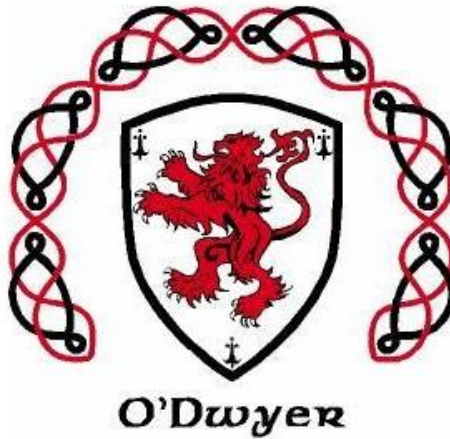

**Advanced Beginner** – A dancer remains an Adv. Beginner in each dance until s/he wins 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup>. The dancer moves up to Novice only for the dance(s) in which s/he has won 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup>. Two steps, three at a time.

## Second Chance Prelim!

In preparation for upcoming Oireachtas season, we are delighted to offer dancers 2 chances to compete in Preliminary Championships.

Second Chance Prelim Champ competitions will have different panels of judges. This competition will be offered at a discounted entry rate: Dancers must compete in regular Prelim in order to be eligible for this competition.

## SECOND CHANCE Preliminary Championships

– Preliminary championships are open to those who, at any NAFC sanctioned Feis: a) have placed 1st in soft shoe and hard shoe as a prizewinner, and b) have never placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in Open Championships. Solo medals will be given for each round. All age groups up to and including Under 15 will dance 3 at a time. Choice of Reel (48 Bars) or Slip Jig (40 Bars); and Jig (48 Bars) or Hornpipe (40 Bars). Rotation numbers will be drawn by computer prior to the day of the feis.: Please note that dancers in Second Chance MUST have entered the regular Prelim competition
